Humans and animals are prohibited from entering any and all water. Domestic animals are prohibited in critical watershed areas as designated. In permitted areas domestic animals must maintain a distance of 100 feet away from all water. Crossing is allowed on bridges only.

- No motorized vehicles permitted on trails. (Street legal vehicles may use Upper Corner Canyon roads when gate is open).
- Domestic animals (dogs, horses) must be leashed in permitted areas. You must collect and properly dispose of all waste.
- Camping and campfires are prohibited within Draper City open space.
- Equestrian trailheads are located at the Equestrian Center and Orson Smith Trailhead.
- Some trails are located in active construction areas, please use caution.
